I was a little surprised to know that you had arranged a tree survey for Saxon Court. Is this a legal requirement? Were we charged?

As you probably remember we use "Offa" tree surgeons on a regular basis to keep the rear garden tended and hopefully safe.

Please advise if we are obliged to have the work done as recommended and if so presumably we can have it done by Offa who I believe will be more cost effective..

James I am in Saxon Court from the 8th to 22nd August if needed. We also require to have the paving lifted and relayed in an approximate 4-6 sq meters just inside of the gates, Willclean cannot do this although they will follow up with removing the moss/weeds and resanding between the stones.
