Please advise if we are obliged to have the work done as recommended and if so presumably we can have it done by Offa who I believe will be more cost effective..

James I am in Saxon Court from the 8th to 22nd August if needed. We also require to have the paving lifted and relayed in an approximate 4-6 sq meters just inside of the gates, Willclean cannot do this although they will follow up with removing the moss/weeds and resanding between the stones.
